5TH MARCH 2013

The month February had fewer activities as many organizations and the community diverted their energy to the then concluded general elections. However the organizing work still went on uninterrupted.

Elections

Kenya concluded a historical event by voting in new leaders on 4th March 2013 under the new constitution. The results are now trickling in indicating Jubilee coalition of Uhuru Kenyatta in an early lead. The election was peaceful and Kenyans are patiently waiting for the final results

ACORN members engaged in mobilizing its members and the entire Korogocho Community in civic education and also making sure that they elect credible leaders. A special team was selected consisting of Four Cos and One member from each village to do monitoring for three days, a day to election during the elections and a day after the election. This was mainly to dictate any early warning signs of violence and report it back for mitigation by the office and the other agencies.
